COWS (as if laughing) Moooo, hoo-hoo! Moooo, hoo-hoo!

SHEEP (as if laughing) Baaaa, ha-ha-ha! Baaaa, ha-ha-ha!

DONKEY (as if laughing) Heeee haw-haw! Heeeee haw-haw!

NARRATOR 1 (covering ears) STOP! You're giving us a headache!

(when it's quiet) What a racket! Ben should have stayed to hear it!

NARRATOR 2 You wait and see, she'll be back at midnight on Christmas Eve –

to find out if Grandma was right!

NARRATOR 1 Talking of grandparents... Donkey has an interesting thing to say.

[DONKEY walks to Downstage Centre.]

DONKEY My (counting on fingers) great, great, great, great, great, great, great,

great... (runs out of fingers) Oh, whatever! My very great grandfather

carried Mary to Bethlehem!

ALL (with mock enthusiasm) Oooo!

[DONKEY returns to place.]

NARRATOR 1 Donkey's very great grandfather was there in the stable the night

Jesus was born.

ALL That's very special.

SHEEP 1 & 2 (sighs) I wish something special could happen in our stable ...

ALL SHEEP (nodding) Baa-aa!

NARRATOR 2 That would be nice, but it's getting late. It's time for sleep!

[All animals respond simultaneously, creating a noisy rabble.]

COWS (nodding and yawning) Mooo! Mooo!

SHEEP (nodding and yawning) Baaaa! Baaaa!

MICE (nodding and yawning) Squeak! Squeak!

ROBINS (nodding and yawning) Tweet! Tweet!

DONKEY (nodding and yawning) Ee-orrre......

NARRATORS (shouting loudly) 1... 2... 3... (clap hands) SLEEP!

[Animals instantly 'go to sleep'.]

Peace at last!

NARRATOR 1 Aren't they lovely when they're asleep? And now... Time is passing!

NARRATOR 2 Through the magic of theatre, it's already Christmas Eve!

[SANTA and ELVES do a dance – see choreography on Page 5]

SANTA AND HIS ELVES – DANCE (© Track 3 / 13)

NARRATORS (shouting) Wake up, animals!

[All ANIMALS wake up with a start, rub eyes, stretch, yawn, etc.]

COW 2 (sleepily) What day is it?

SHEEP It's Christmas Eve!

ROBINS Time to sing 'Away in a manger!'

[ALL adopt 'singer' pose, hands clasped together, elbows out.]

ALL (singing) 'Away in a manger, no crib for a bed...'

NARRATOR 1 Very tuneful...

NARRATOR 2 Look at Donkey! He's puzzled. He's been wondering what a

way is.

DONKEY (hands on hips, puzzled) A way in a manger...

(scratches head, then holds hands open) What is a way?

ROBIN 1 Away means... (big pointing gesture with wing) far away!

NARRATOR 1 That's right, but a way can be something else too. It's how we get

somewhere. When baby Jesus grew up he said he was the way.

DONKEY The way to what?

NARRATOR 2 The way to get to know God. Because God's invisible, it's hard to

understand him otherwise.

COW 1 I thought God was an old man in the sky.

COW 2 (nodding) Moo! With a big white beard!

NARRATOR 2 No, that's not true. We don't know what God looks like. But we

know who he is, because Jesus taught us about him.

DONKEY All I know is that God must be (opens out arms) HUGE!

BIGGER THAN THE BIGGEST MOUNTAIN

Make mountain shape in air

BIGGER THAN THE BIGGEST MOUNTAIN, TALLER THAN THE TALLEST TREE.

Shield brow and look L. on 'East', R. on 'West'

HE'S THE DESERT AND THE SEA! (CLAP, CLAP)

Make twinkly fingers in air

Splay hands by
