# **Director's Notes**

#### **SUMMARY**

I-Spy Nativity tells the Christmas story through a game of I-spy where 'd' is for donkey, 'a' is for angel, etc. With just seven songs and simple, formulaic script in between, this is as easy as it gets!

### **CAST LIST**

# **Speaking parts**

Teacher Main part, for confident child (or could be an adult)

Child 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 Take turns to be the person who does the 'I-Spy'

All Children All speak to do the guessing; 'Is it a duck?' etc., using picture prompts

Can take part all the time, dressed either as named role or as additional

angels, animals, shepherds, etc.

## Non-speaking parts (in order of appearance)

3 x innkeepers, Joseph, Mary, donkey, angels, shepherds, star, 3 x kings, camels (optional) stable animals

#### **PROPS**


15 placards for children to hold up in I-Spy game (see adjoining page)

### **Traditional Nativity items**

Manger and doll to represent baby Jesus; stool or small chair for Mary/Joseph. Crooks for Shepherds (optional); gold, frankincense and myrrh for Three Kings.

#### **STAGING**

The manger is set Upstage Centre with two stools or chairs behind it. If possible, a stable backdrop of some kind would create a good setting. The children are all seated or stand as shown below.



# **Director's Overview**

#### Incidental I-SPY CHRISTMAS

Track 1/9

The children want to play I Spy. Teacher chooses the first person to have a turn. Child 1 spies something beginning with ' $\mathbf{d}'$  - it's a donkey.

#### SONG IT'S A DONKEY

• Track 2 / 10

The children play again. Teacher chooses the next person to have a turn. Child 2 spies something beginning with ' $\mathbf{b}$ ' - it's a baby.

### SONG MARY HAD A BABY (DID YOU KNOW?)

• Track 3 / 11

They play again. Teacher chooses the next person to have a turn. Child 3 spies something beginning with  $\mathbf{\dot{a}}'$  - it's angels.

#### SONG WE HAVE NEWS TO TELL YOU

• Track 4 / 12

They play again. Teacher chooses the next person to have a turn. Child 4 spies something beginning with  $\mathbf{k}'$  - it's kings.

#### SONG BUMPETY, BUMPETY, BUMP

• Track 5 / 13

They play again. Teacher says it's their last turn. Child 5 spies something beginning with 's' - it's a stable.

SONG EVERYONE'S IN THE STABLE

• Track 6 / 14

SONG I SPY CHRISTMAS

• Track 7 / 15

SONG WE WISH YOU A MERRY CHRISTMAS

• Track 8 / 16

The guesses that everyone make in the I-Spy game may be prompted by placards held up by children. For example, here is a set to match the things beginning with 'd'. There are A3 and A4 templates for these placards on the data section of the enhanced CD.
