Director's Notes

SUMMARY

We all make journeys at Christmas! This retelling of the Nativity story follows the journeys of its characters as they travel to Bethlehem, all needing a little help on their way. The show opens with a song about present day Christmas journeys, and then we follow Mary and Joseph towards Bethlehem, where Jesus is born. Next, angels lead a group of shepherds, running, skipping and bouncing all the way to Bethlehem! The three wise men follow a star to find the baby, with Superstar Camel carrying the heavy gold. Finally everyone reaches the stable, and all sing to celebrate the birth of baby Jesus.

Manger Frankincense - a fancy jar, labelled

Chairs for Mary and Joseph
Lamb soft toy

Myrrh - another fancy jar, labelled
Walking stick for Old Camel

Shepherds crooks Sling for Weak Camel

Bethlehem star Sunglasses for Superstar Camel (optional - for all Chorus)

COSTUMES

Costumes are as required for any conventional nativity (i.e. dressing gowns, tea towels, angel robes, animal headgear, three wise men) plus Santa, postman etc.

STAGING SUGGESTIONS

Choir situated on 2 sides of the stable setup. It may be helpful that the wise men start at one side and travel in, shepherds from the opposite and travel to the centre.

All children sing the songs.

Director's Overview

Song CHRISTMAS JOURNEYS ⊙ Track 1 / 12

Mary and Joseph have to get to Bethlehem, but how can they get there? A friendly farmer offers to lend them his donkey. Now they just need to find the way.

Song WHICH WAY TO BETHLEHEM? ⊙ Track 2 / 13

Mary and Joseph travel to Bethlehem arriving very tired, but there is no-where for them to stay until an innkeeper offers them his stable. It's here that Baby Jesus is born.
